


KEEP OUR LINEWORKERS SAFE!

Electricity is very dangerous! Before workers can fix or maintain power lines and electrical equipment, they need the right safety gear. Peel these stickers off and put them on the lineworkers on the other side of this sheet to get them ready for a day on the job!

Safety Glasses

Hard plastic lenses protect the eyes.



Hard Hat

Lineworkers are required to protect their heads from electrical hazards and falling debris.



Hearing Protection

Workers wear earmuffs to reduce noise.




Rubber Sleeves

These are worn over the arms to protect workers from unintentional contact with an energized power source.



Hot Stick

This tool is used to move or adjust live electrical equipment. It is usually made of insulated fiberglass and is extendable up to 40 feet!




SAFETY FIRST!



Hand Line

The hand line is a rope that is used to hoist equipment and for emergency missions.



Gloves

Special rubber insulation in these gloves protect against electric shock and burn.




Work Boots

Ceramic- or steel-toed boots made of a special type of rubber or leather are worn to protect the feet and provide support for climbing.




Safety Harness

To reduce the chance of falling, workers wear a safety harness when working up high.




Pants

Utility workers wear clothes that are fire resistant. They also wear climbers to just below the knee to hold their gaffs (sharp steel points that are used to climb utility poles).
