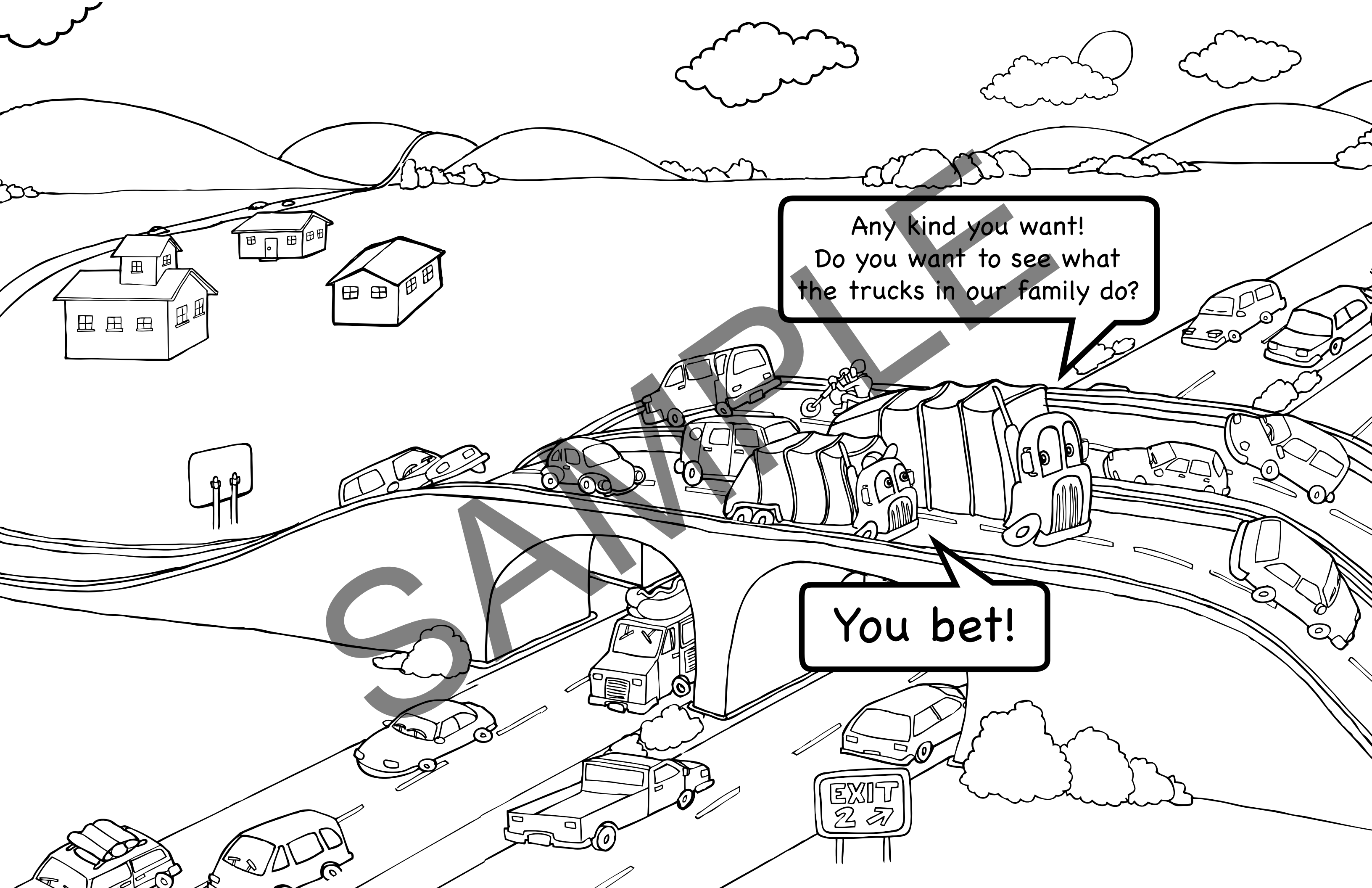
Hi, kids! I'm Timmy.

What kind of job can I do?

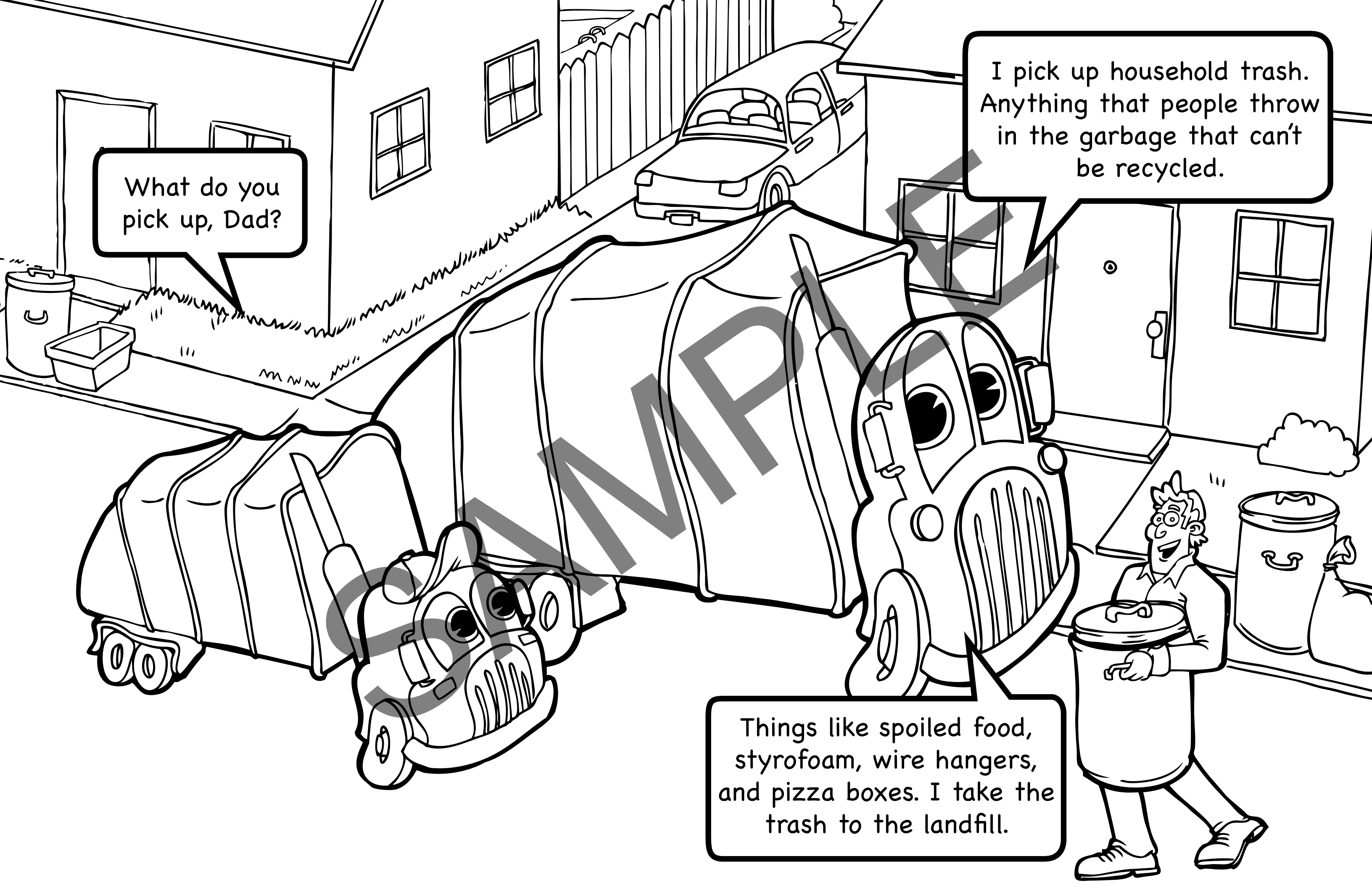

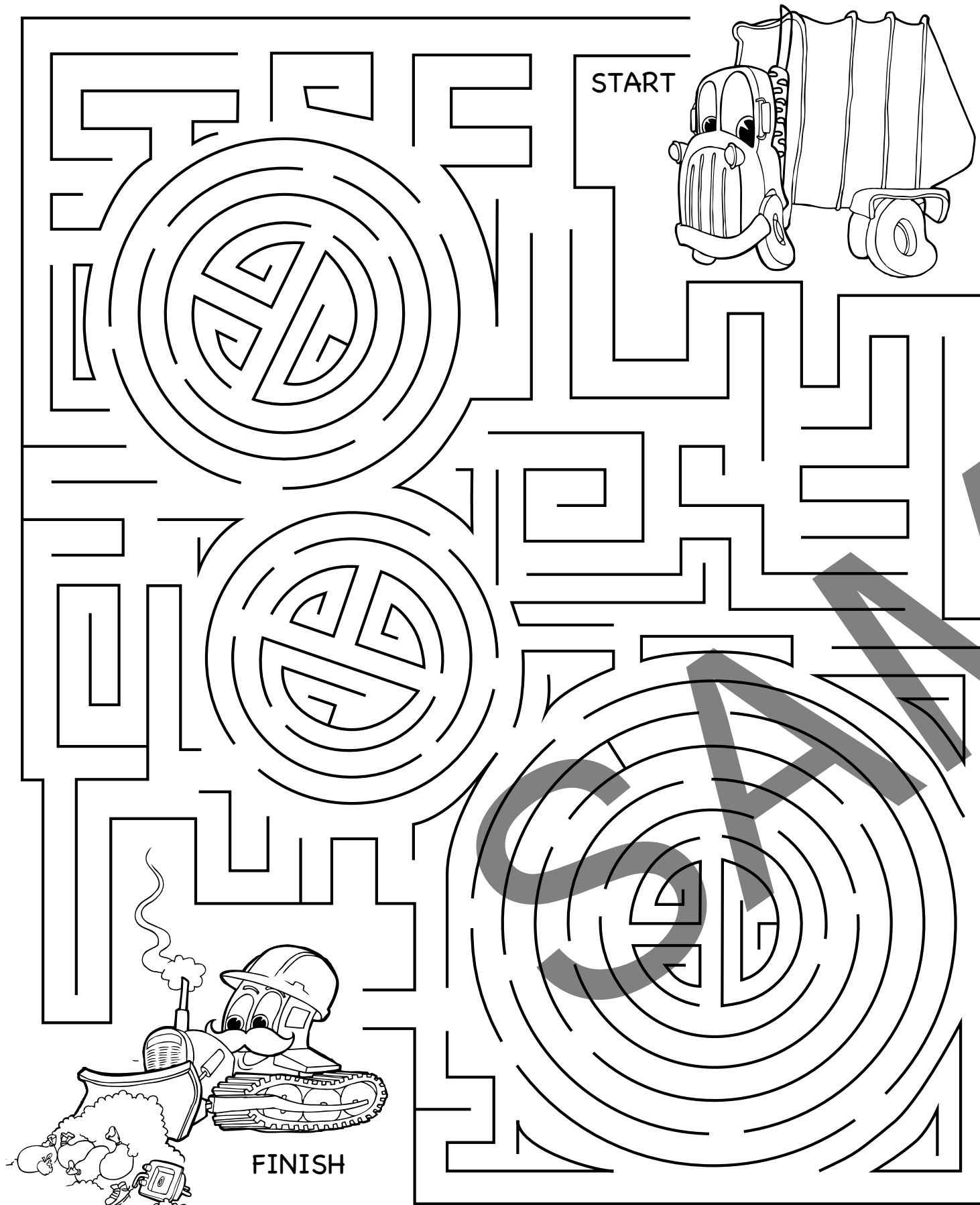


What do you pick up, Dad?

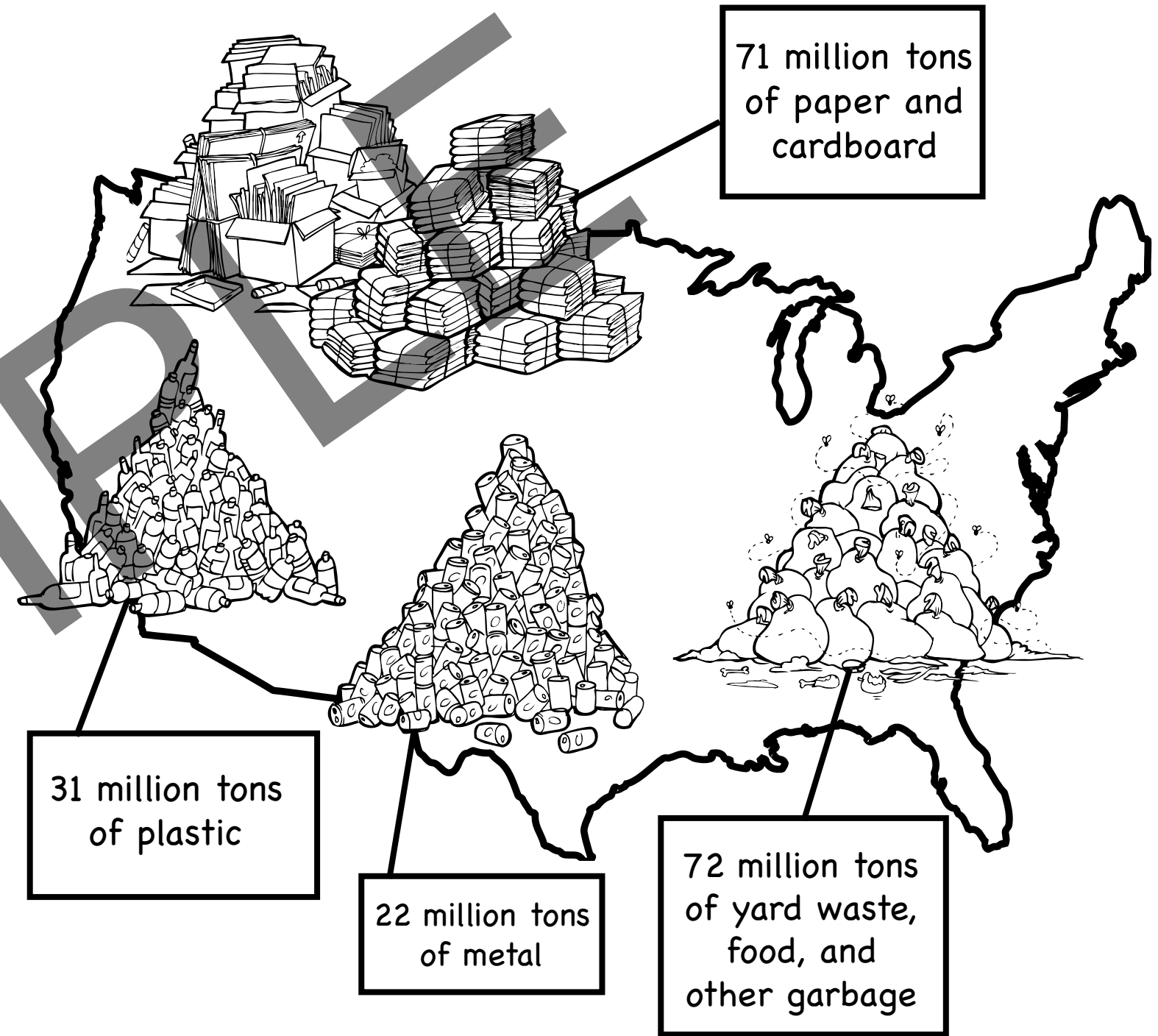
I pick up household trash. Anything that people throw in the garbage that can't be recycled.

Every year, we produce MILLIONS of TONS of trash!

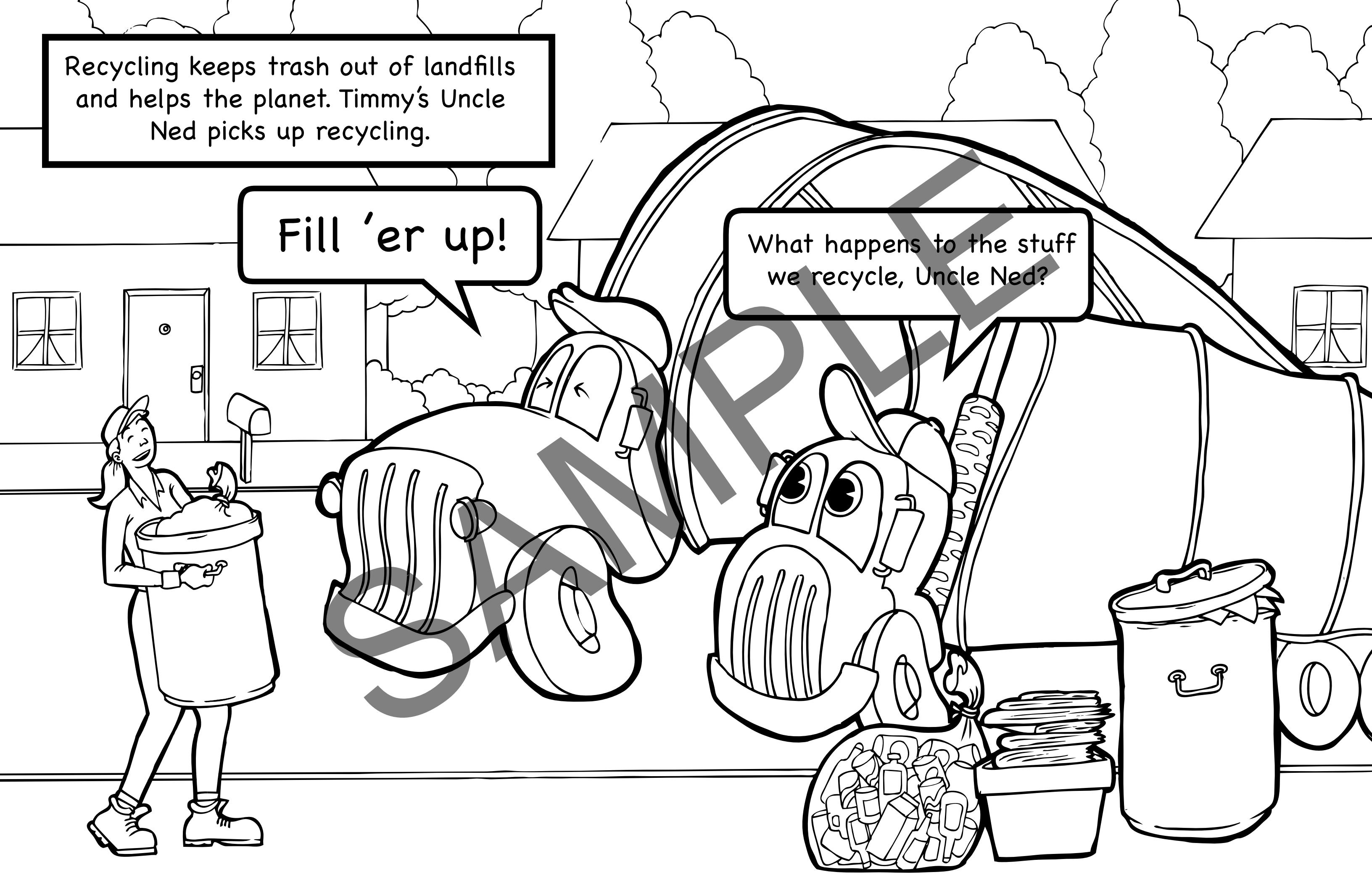


Landfills can't hold all of that trash. That's why it's important to recycle.

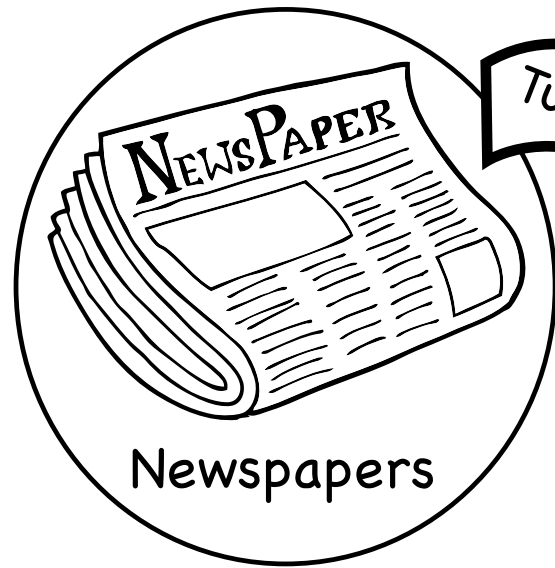
Recycling keeps trash out of landfills and helps the planet. Timmy's Uncle Ned picks up recycling.

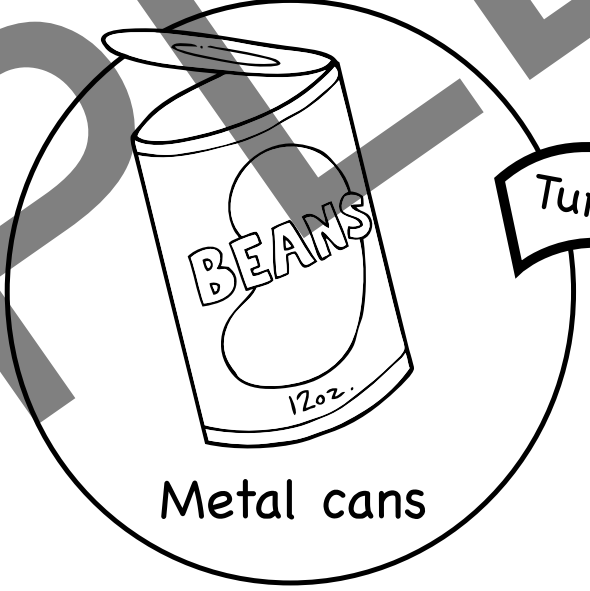
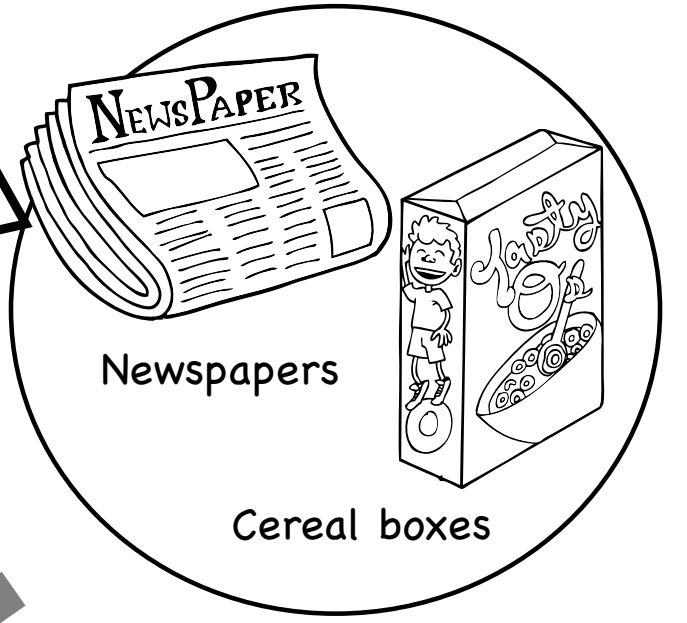
When we recycle, our old things get turned into new and useful things.



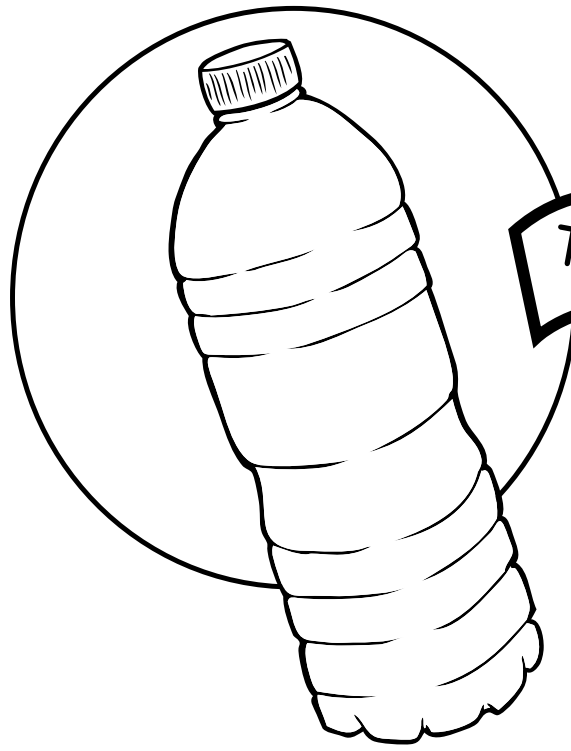
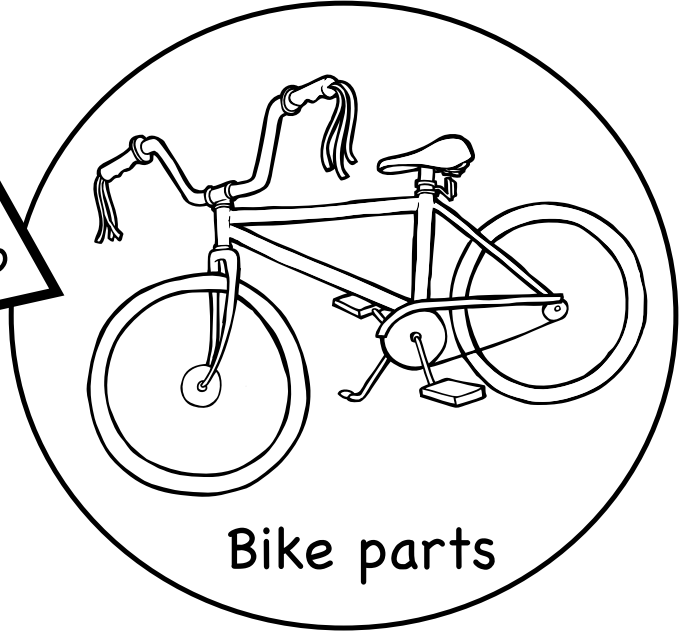

Composting is a form of recycling. Composting turns yard waste into fertilizer for plants and trees.

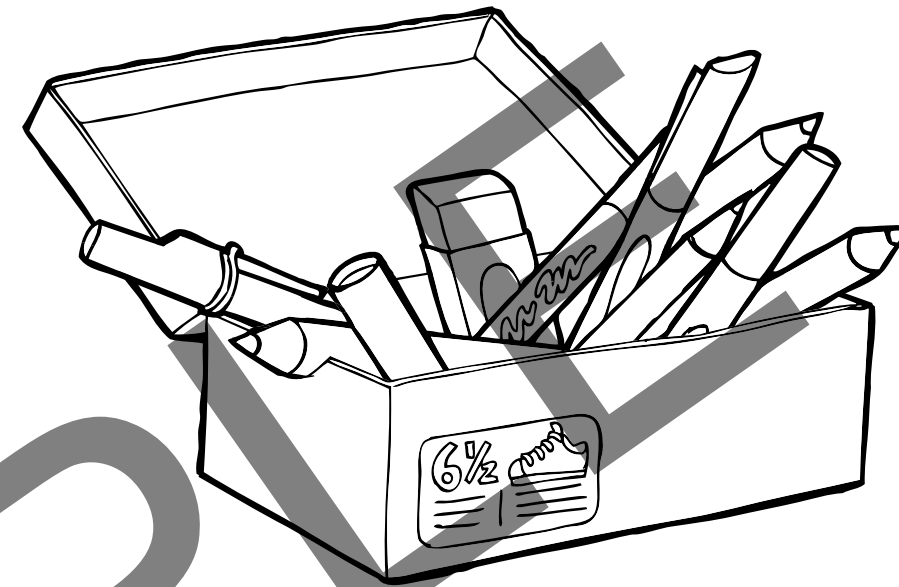
Are there more ways to keep trash out of landfills?

You bet! One great way is to reduce the amount of stuff we throw out.

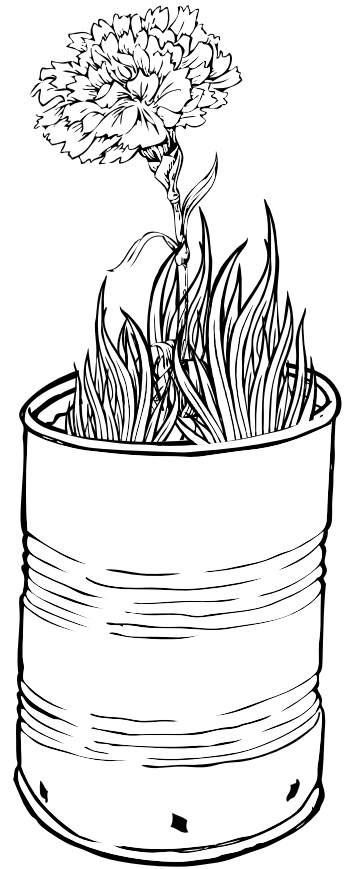


Bring old clothes to the thrift store!

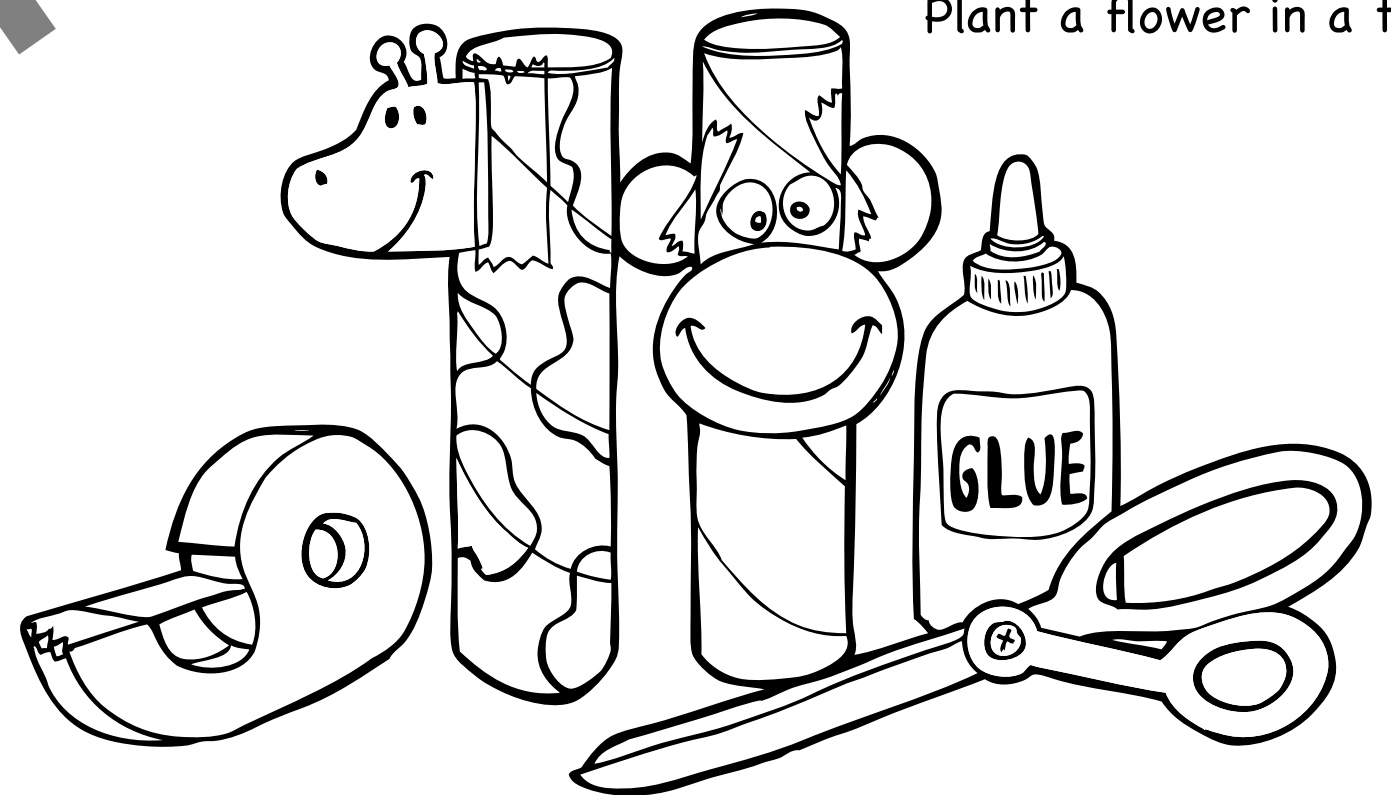
We can also reuse things instead of throwing them out.



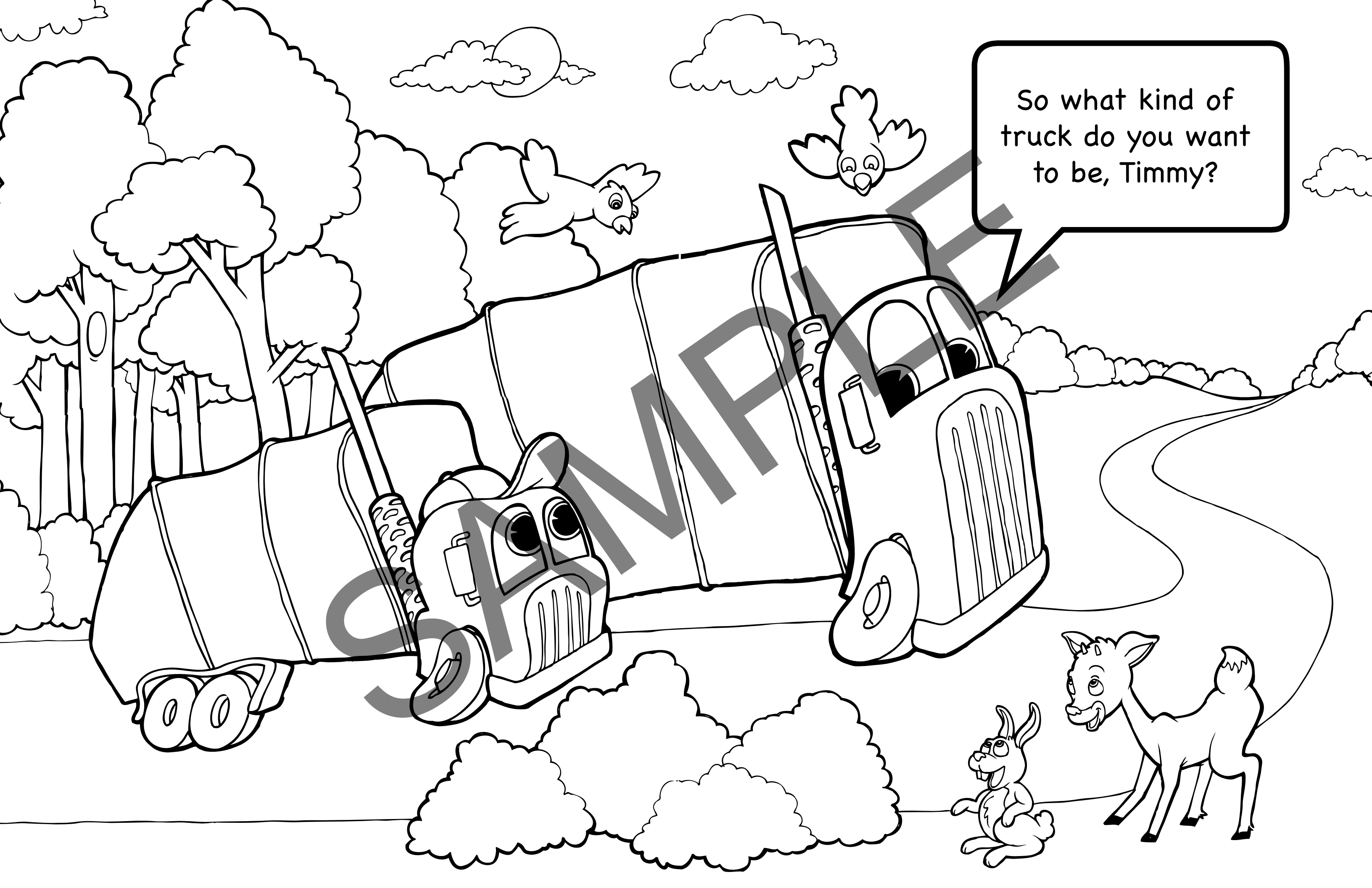
Keep your pencils in a shoebox!



Plant a flower in a tin can!

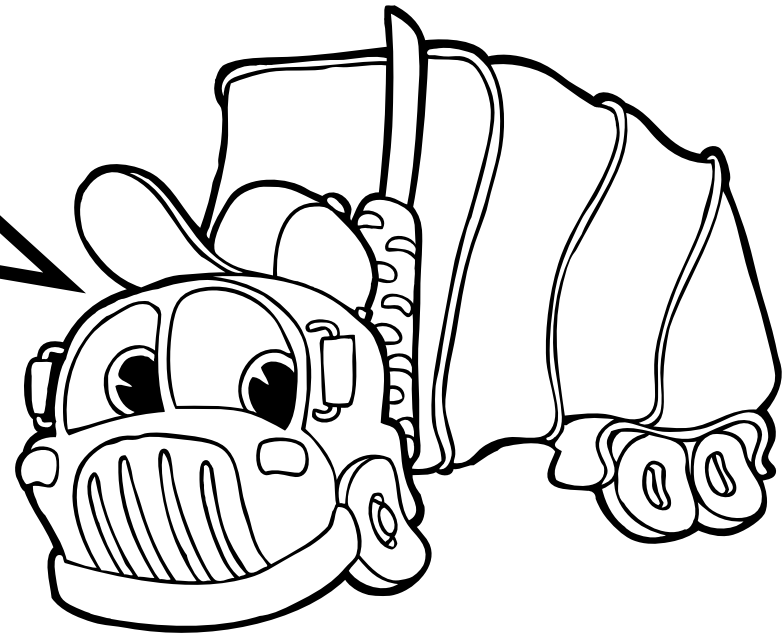


Make wacky animals out of paper towel rolls!

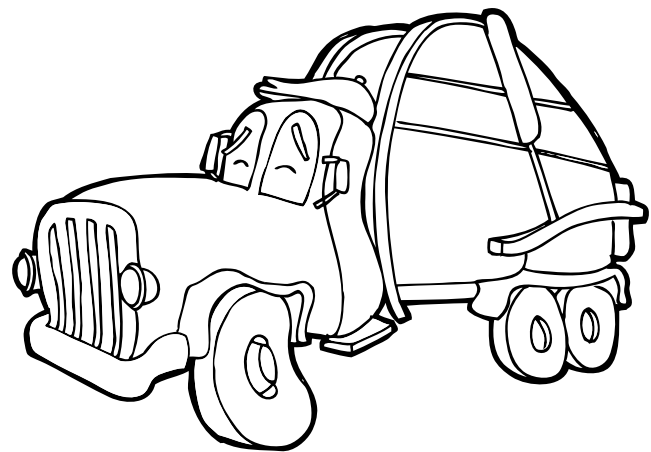

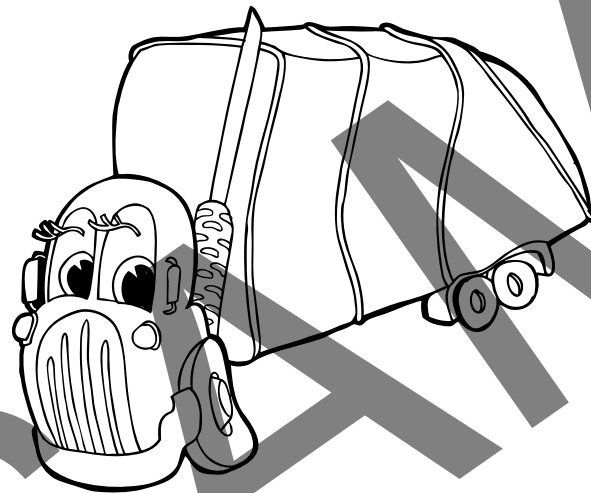
After I thought about what everyone said, I decided I want to be a recycling truck! That way I can help keep trash out of landfills!



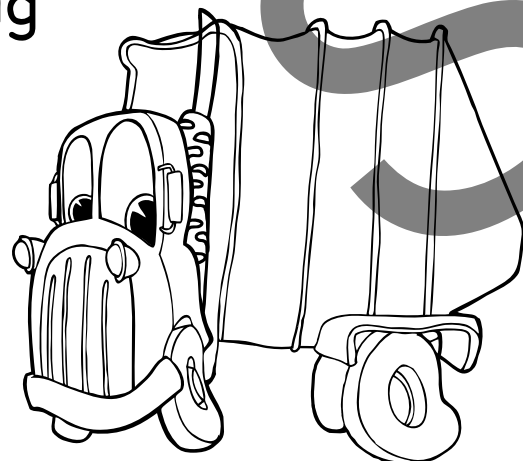
