

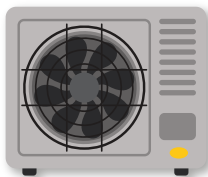

Regularly cleaning the filter means saving energy and cleaner dishes. Check your manual for instructions.

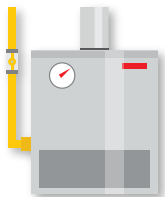
