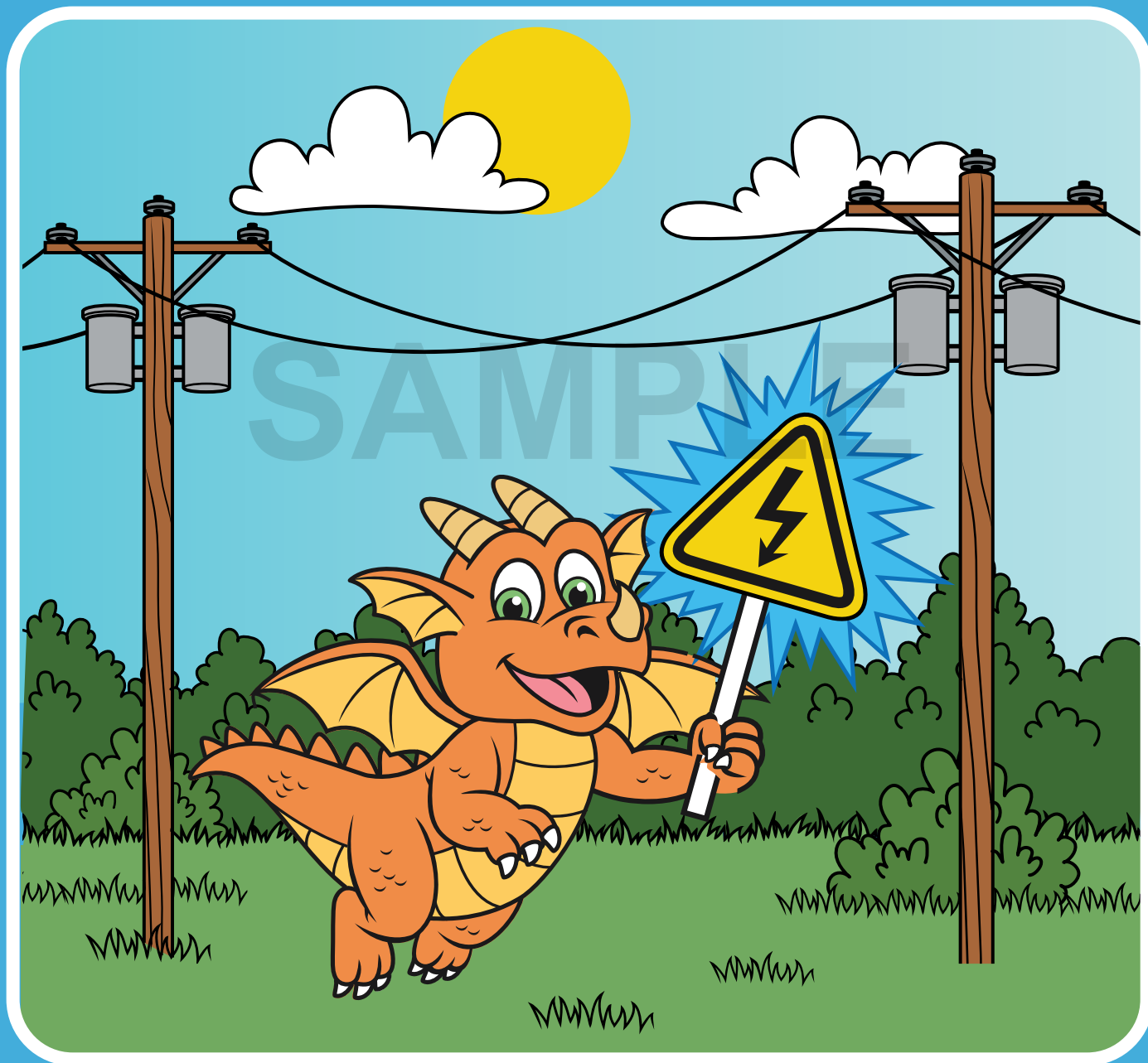


Dash the Dragon Learns About **POWER LINE SAFETY**



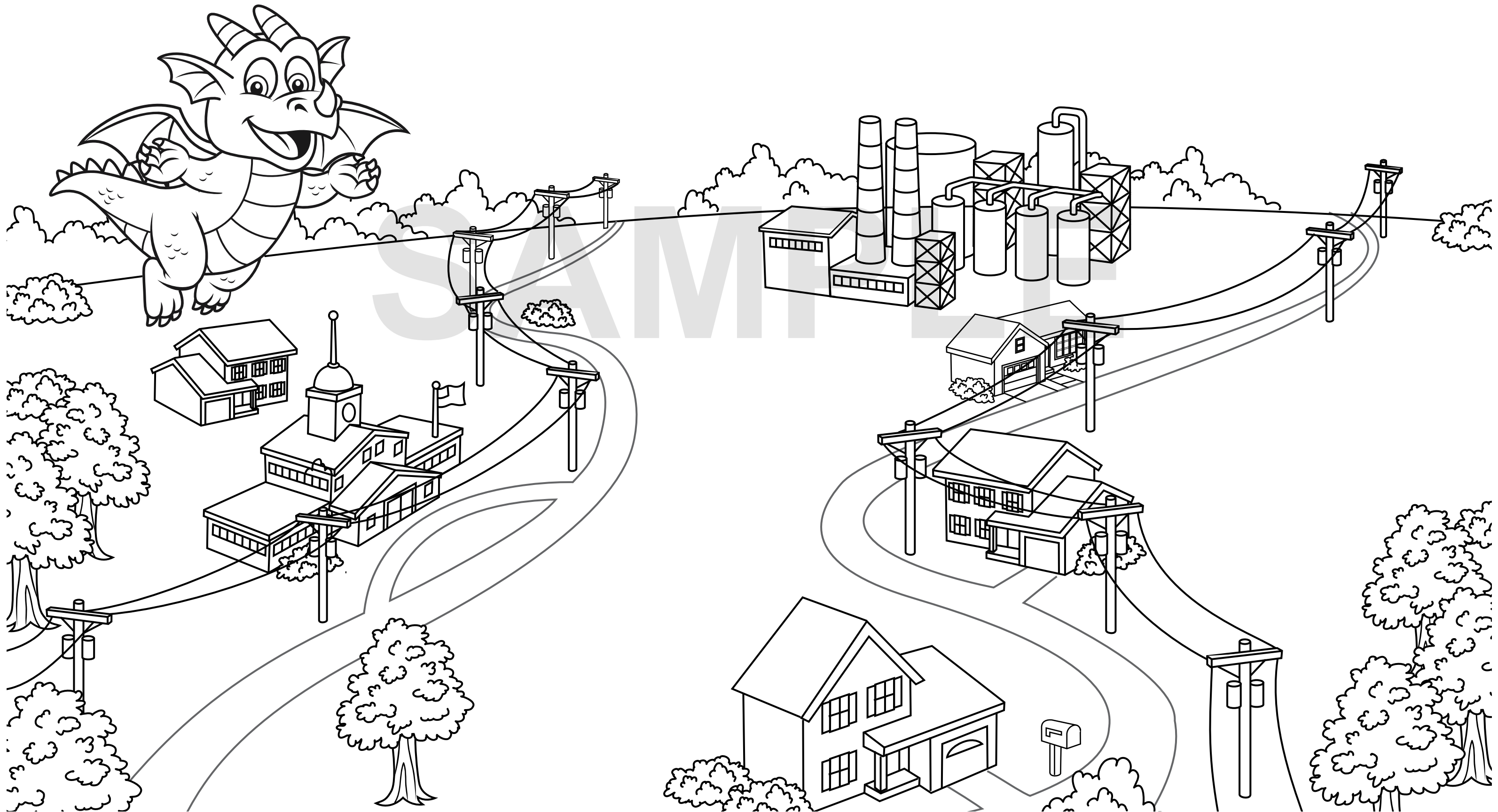
**Hi, I'm Dash the Dragon and I'm here to teach you
about power line safety!**



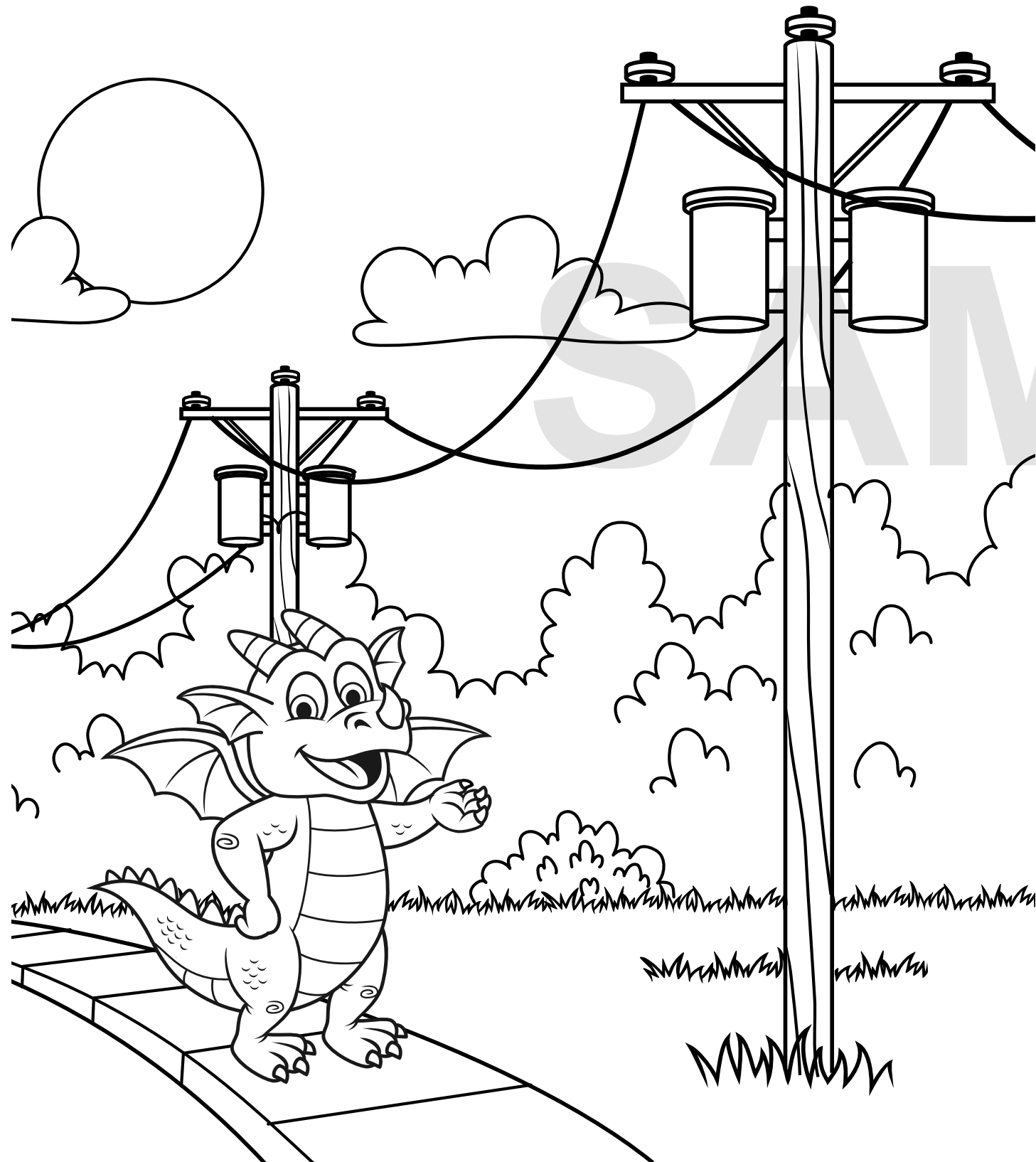

Electricity helps us every day. It's brought to our homes, schools, and businesses using big wires called power lines.

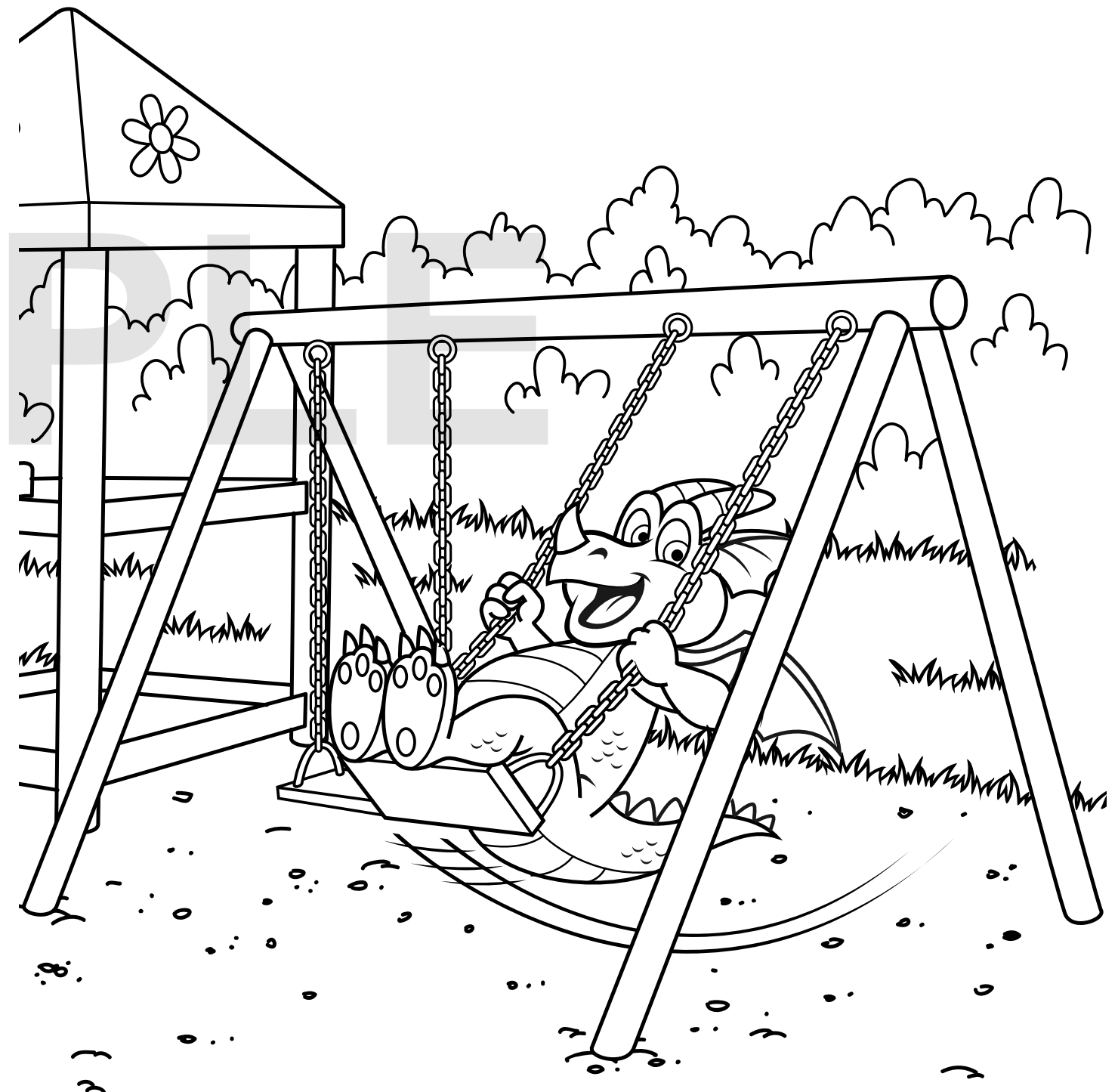
We use electricity for so many things in our homes, but we must be careful around it.



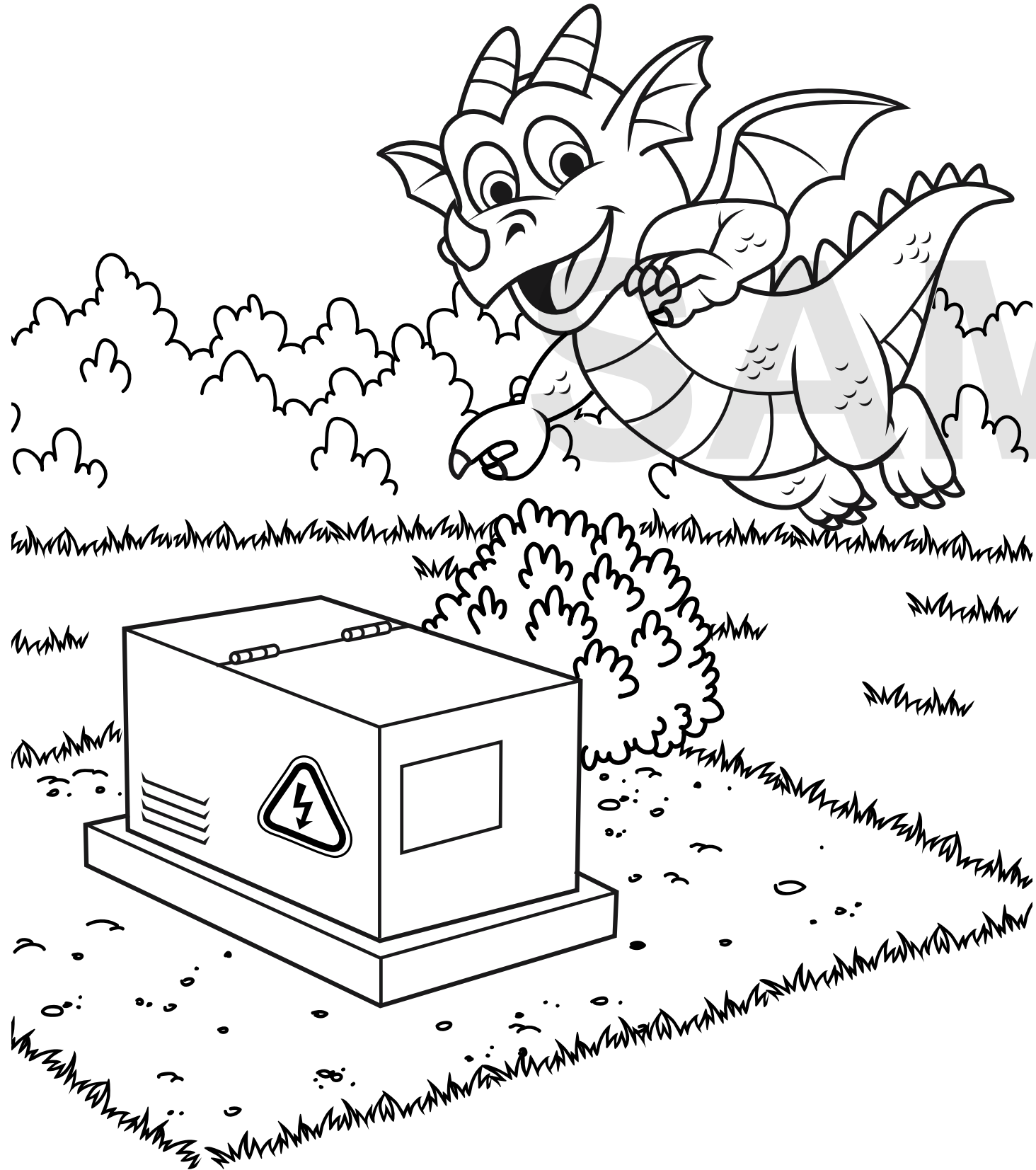
You might see power lines on top of big poles by the side of the road. Stay far away from them - and keep kites, drones, and balloons far away too.



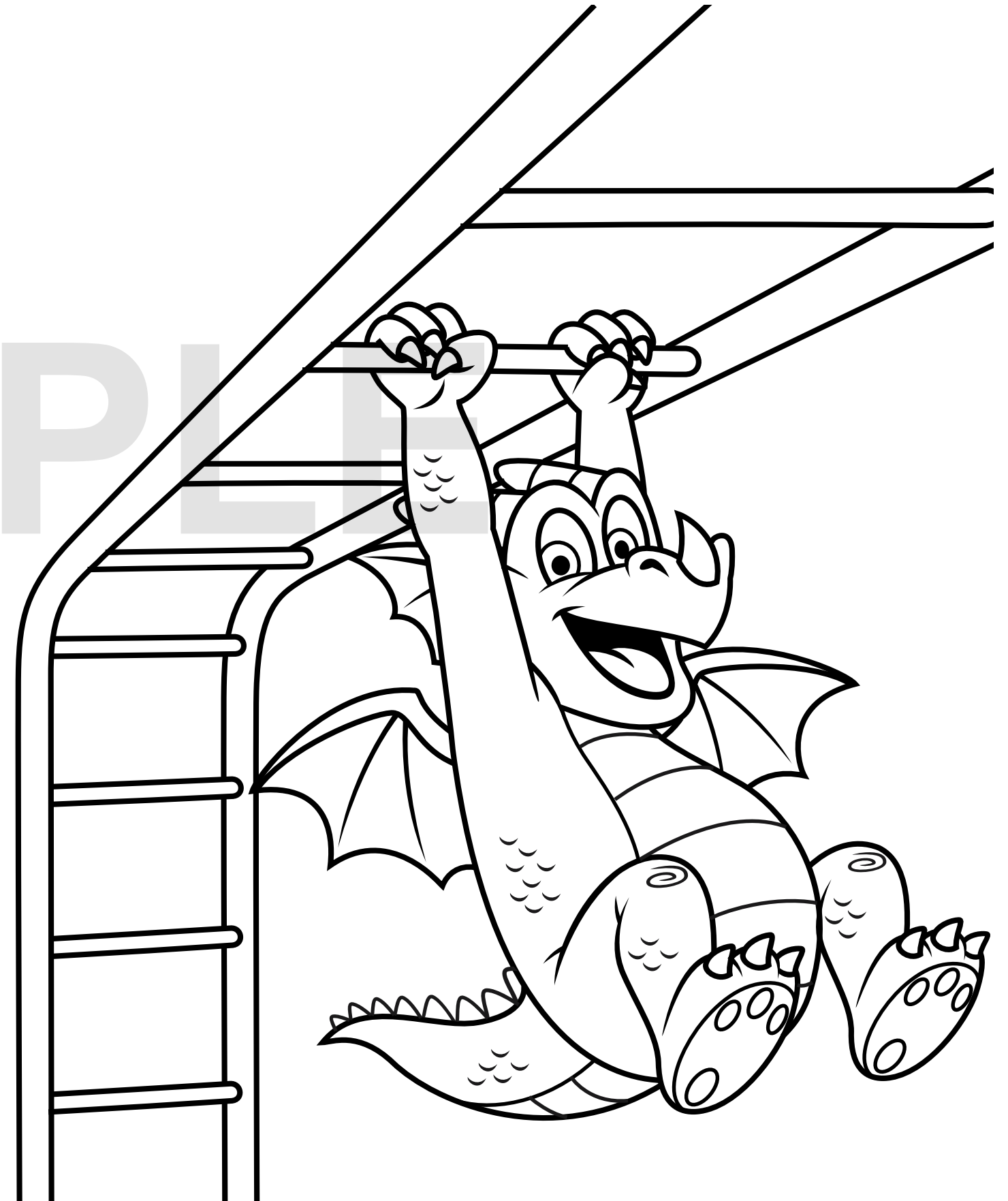
If you want to play, do it at the playground!



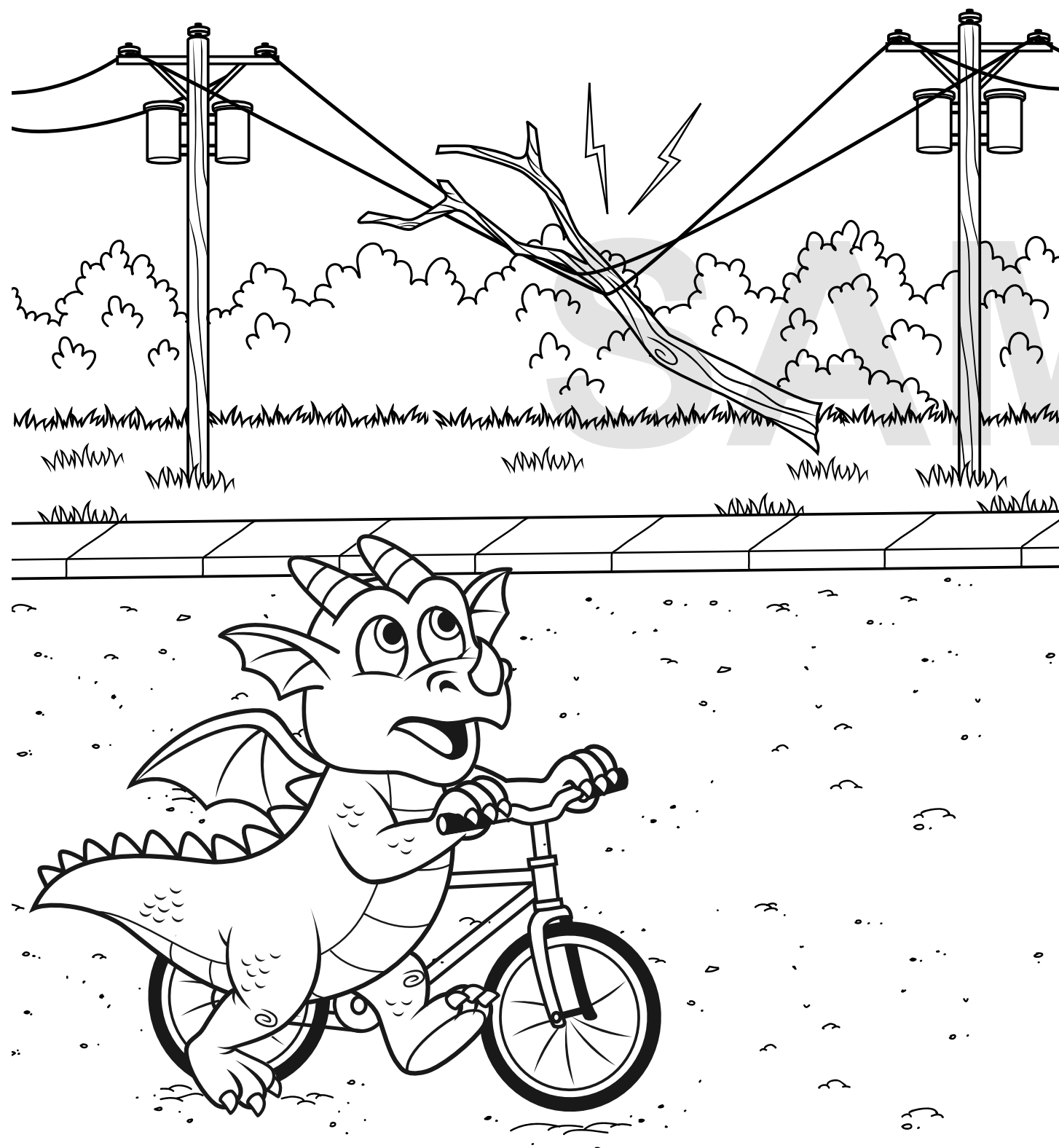
You might see metal boxes marked with a lightning bolt, these have electricity in them. So never touch or climb on them.



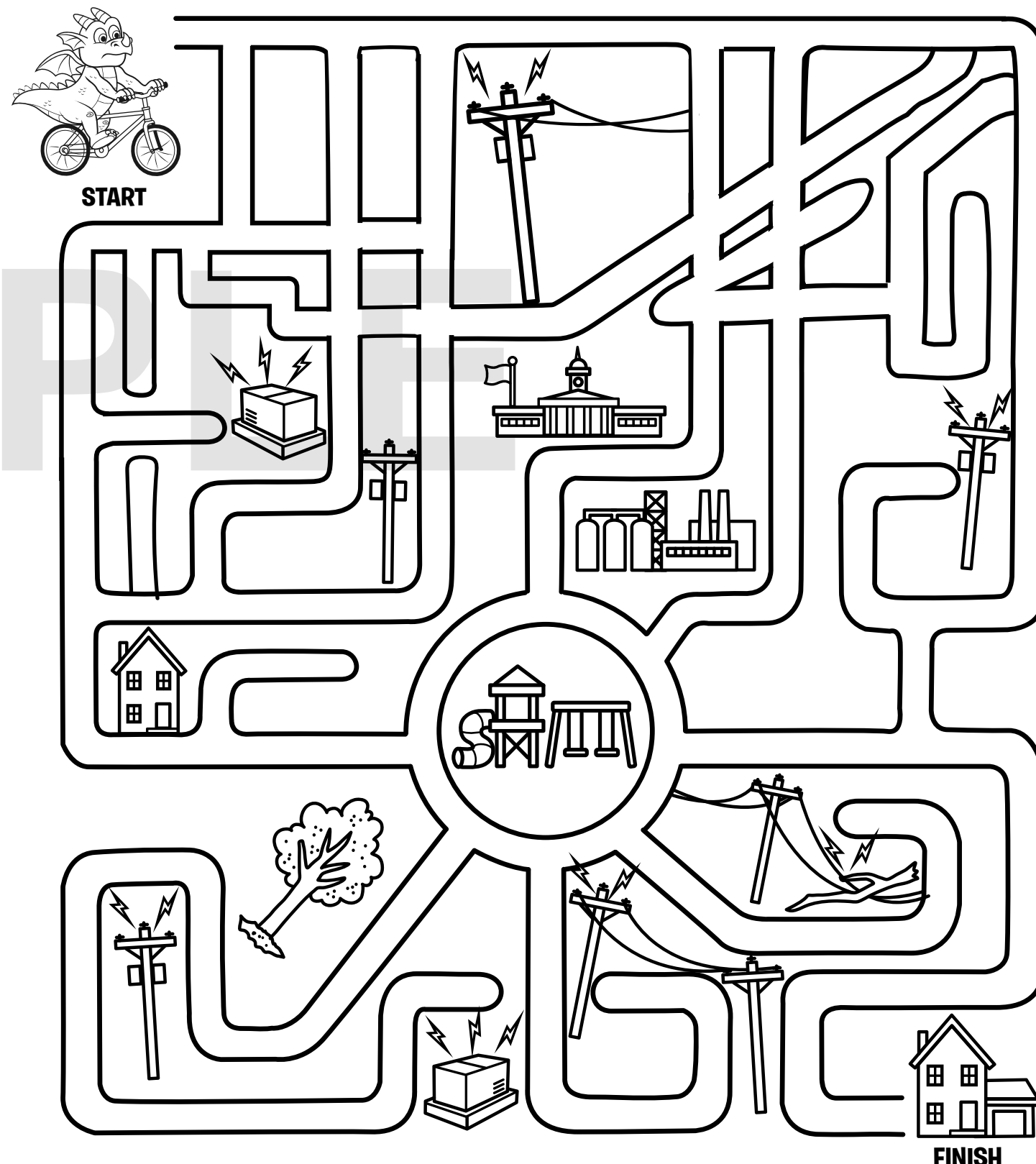
If you want to climb, do it on a jungle gym!



Power lines are especially dangerous when they are damaged. Downed power lines can send electricity through the ground near them. It's important to stay far away and never touch a fallen wire!



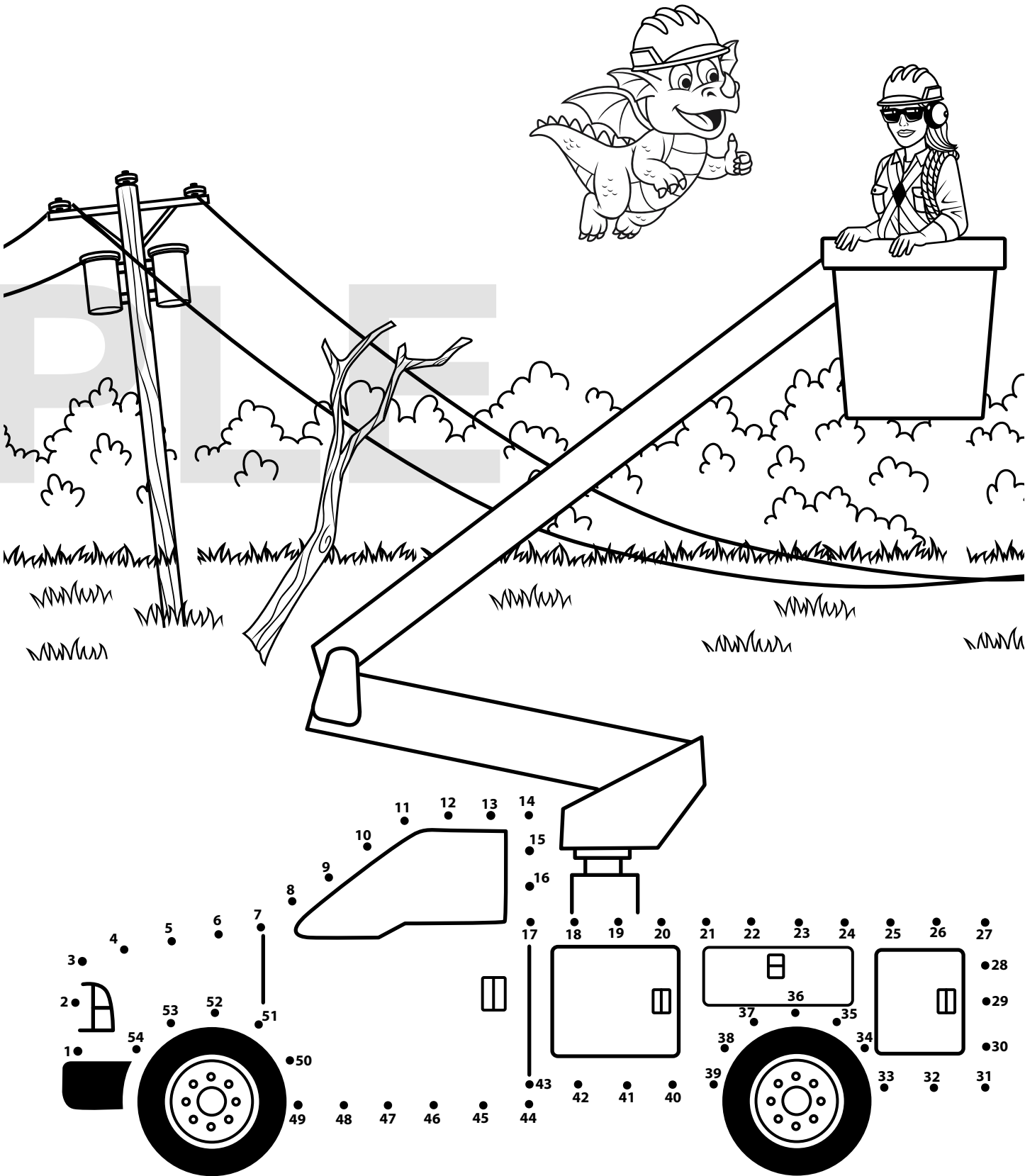
Even if you think the electricity is shut off from the power line, stay far away. Can you help Dash get home while avoiding the electrical hazards?



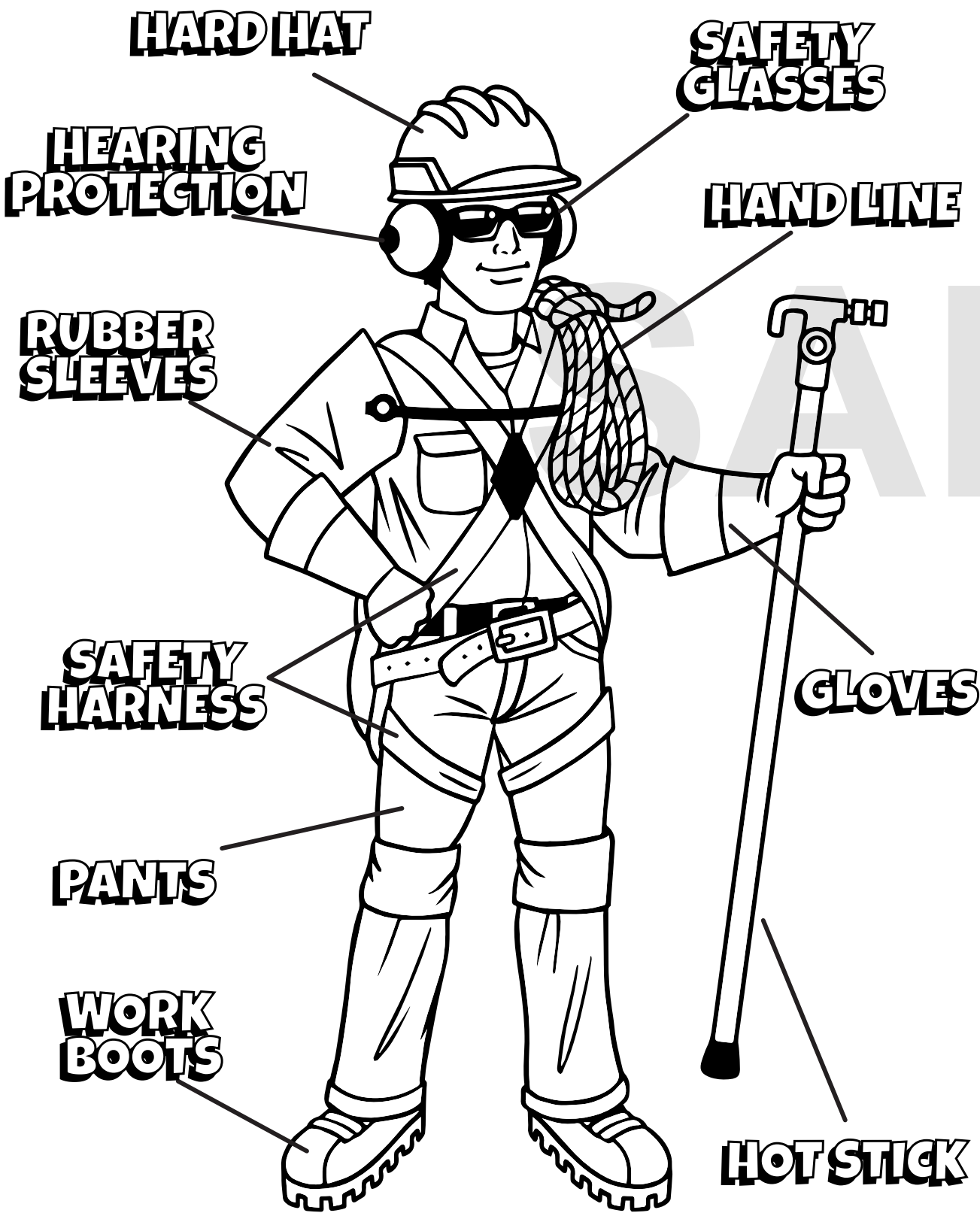
Sometimes electrical equipment can be damaged in storms. Stay inside when the weather gets bad.



After storms utility workers move quickly to repair damage. Can you connect the dots to see one of their trucks?



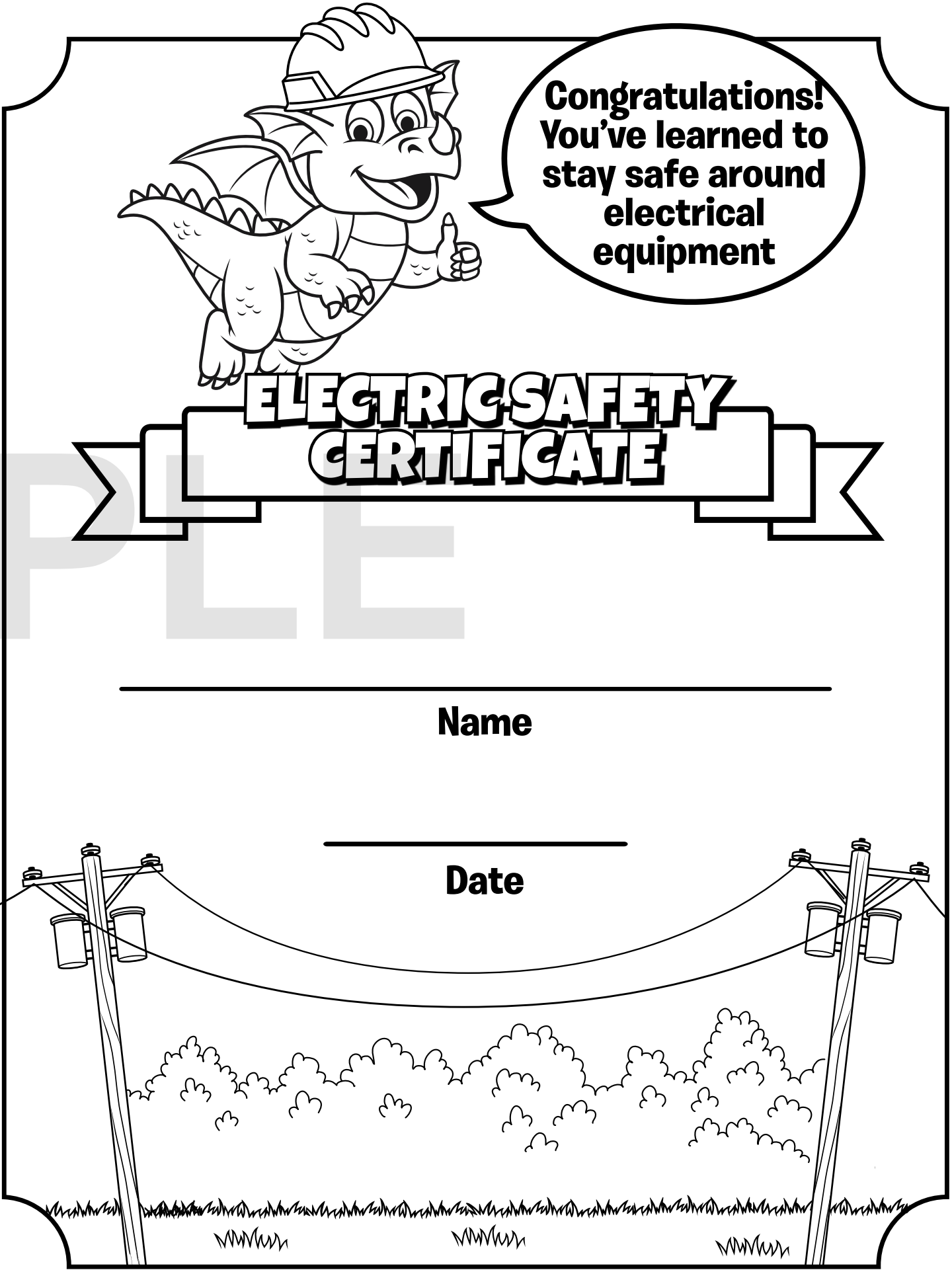
Only trained workers can fix power lines. They use lots of special gear to keep them protected, but it's still dangerous work.



Utility workers also sometimes trim the branches of trees if they are too close to power lines.
