


DON'T FLUSH THIS BOOK!



Hi! We're Wendell and Penelope, and we're here to talk about what should and shouldn't go in the toilet.





**Toilets are amazing!
Underneath your toilet there's a
pipe. When you flush, everything
in the bowl goes down that pipe.**

**For most of us, the pipe leads to a big system
of more pipes that are all connected.**




**Everything you flushed
ends up at a wastewater
treatment plant, where
the water gets cleaned.**

**For some people, it leads to a
septic tank.**



**It's important that the pipes don't get clogged.
That could be a problem for everyone!**

We have a simple rule about what should go in the toilet:



**IF IT'S NOT
FROM YOUR
BODY, DON'T
PUT IT IN
THE POTTY**
(unless it's toilet paper!)

Another way to remember is the 3 Ps:



**That's all that should go in the toilet.
Everything else should stay OUT!**

Here are some things that should NEVER go in the toilet:




WIPES



**PAPER
TOWELS**

**(AND ANY PAPER THAT'S
NOT TOILET PAPER)**



FISH



**STUFFED
ANIMALS**



GREASE AND OIL



TOYS


If something that's not supposed to be there is flushed, it could get stuck and block the pipe.




If the pipe is blocked, the toilet could break. Water or waste could start coming back up.





It can be very hard to get a pipe or toilet unclogged. There are people called plumbers whose job it is to work on pipes. You may need their help if a clog is very bad!




Sometimes clogs can form in the pipes that connect a city or town to the wastewater treatment plant. Connect the dots to see a truck that's used to clear those big clogs.



**Can you get through this maze?
Don't get stuck in the clogs!**



**Toilet paper is made differently than other types of
paper. It's safe to flush because it dissolves in water.
Just don't use too much!**



So remember:

**IF IT'S NOT FROM
YOUR BODY,
DON'T PUT IT IN
THE POTTY**

(unless it's toilet paper!)
