**Hi! We're Wendell and Penelope, and we're here to teach you about littering.**


**Do you know what litter is?**

**Litter is trash that's left lying around instead of it being put in the bin where it belongs.**

SAMPLE




**We hate to see litter on the ground in our neighborhoods and parks. Food wrappers, empty cans, bottles, and other trash should go in the bin!**



**Litter can cause lots of problems, so make sure your trash makes it to the trash can, even if it's something small like a gum wrapper.**

**Litter in the street can get washed into storm drains, which lead to local waterways. It might harm animals or clog the drains and cause flooding.**




**Never throw your trash out a car window. Put it in a bag until you get to a trash can.**




**DID YOU KNOW?**

**Animals sometimes eat litter, thinking it's food. It can make them very sick.**

Another kind of littering is not cleaning up after pets.  
Dog waste can end up in local waterways if it's not  
put in the trash, or someone might step in it.  
So, remember to scoop the poop!




Keep an eye out for different kinds of trash bins.  
Sometimes we need to separate our trash into  
paper, metal and glass, food waste for compost, and

Can you help put the litter in the trash by getting through this maze?


